Bishop Folda indicated that the Diocese will release names of abusive clergy of the past fifty years, as other diocese' have done. It is taking some time to finalize the list, sorting allegations from substantiated cases. This is to be done as part of the healing process and work on moving forward.

Liturgy Office reminded us of our former bishops' directive that **when the priest is away, we do not hold communion services** in the parish. This is to set apart the special character of the Mass, at which the Eucharist is consecrated and received. **Other things could be offered such as morning prayer with the readings of the day, holy hour and Rosary, etc.** We will work with the various parishioners who frequently attend, to work on options and preferences.
