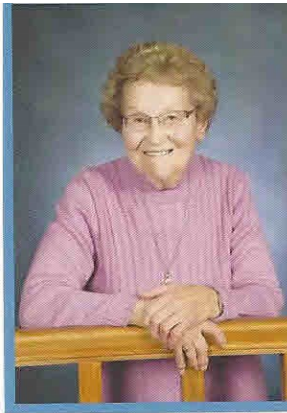

What does "Enthronement" Mean?

The ENTHRONEMENT of the Sacred Heart means (in the words of Father Mateo) *the Official and Social recognition of the loving Kingship of the Heart of Jesus in the Christian family.* The family shows this recognition by giving the image of the Sacred Heart a place of honor in the home and dedicating itself to Him by an act of consecration. In this way the family is brought under the benign influence of the Divine Heart, which asserts itself in all the events of family life.

Here's an Easy Way to Help Fill Shelves of Our Local Food Pantry:
"Get One/Give One" (Griggs County Ministerium Project)

Everyone likes a good BOGO (Buy One Get One Free offer.) But what about the person who does not have enough money to feed themselves and/or their family? How can they benefit from a BOGO? You can help them. That's right, what if you took advantage of the BOGO and donated that item(s) to the local food bank or family in need? What if you **Get One** and **Give One**?

The fact is there are many in our community, children included, that go to bed hungry. Others make choices to pay for medication or food, these are not choices that anyone should even have to think about, but they are.

So, consider participating in Get One/Give One. There are 3 ways to do this: First, inform your checker at Miller's that you want to give one to the food bank, the checker will set that item aside to be taken to the food shelf right here in Cooper. Second, you can take the items to the food shelf yourself. Finally, you can bring the items to Trinity Lutheran and the church will make sure it gets delivered. We always encourage you to shop locally but if you run across a deal in another town, bring the item(s) you **Got and **Give** it here in Cooper.**
