Consecration to St Joseph: You Can Still Do This as Individuals or Families:

If you start Monday the 29th or Tuesday the 30th, we can use the Feast of St Joseph the Worker, May 1, as target for the 33 day consecration fulfillment here.

Personal or family consecration through the 33 days of prayer using the book by Fr Don Calloway, "Consecration to St Joseph." See Father Dale for a copy. Or you can log onto the Fargo Diocese web site, go to "Resources/Prayer Resources" and go to the Consecration tab where you will find a meditation and prayer for each of the 33 days.

Gods Gift Appeal: So far the Diocese has received from us: \$2280 from Aneta, Cooperstown \$6568, Finley \$4160 and Jessie \$6366. Keep it up!

Here's an Easy Way to Help Fill Shelves of Our Local Food Pantry: "Get One/Give One" (Griggs County Ministerium Project)

The fact is there are many in our community, children included, that go to bed hungry. Others make choices to pay for medication or food, these are not choices that anyone should even have to think about, but they are.

So, consider participating in Get One/Give One. There are 3 ways to do this: First, inform your checker at Miller's that you want to give one to the food bank, the checker will set that item aside to be taken to the food shelf right here in Cooper. Second, you can take the items to the food shelf yourself. Finally, you can bring the items to Trinity Lutheran and the church will make sure it gets delivered. We always encourage you to shop locally but if you run across a deal in another town, bring the item(s) you Got and Give it here in Cooper.

What does "Enthronement" Mean?

The ENTHRONEMENT of the Sacred Heart means (in the words of Father Mateo) *the Official and Social recognition of the loving Kingship of the Heart of Jesus in the Christian family.* The family shows this recognition by giving the image of the Sacred Heart a place of honor in the home and dedicating itself to Him by an act of consecration. In this way the family is brought under the benign influence of the Divine Heart, which asserts itself in all the events of family life.
