### **Message From Bishop Folda Regarding Bishop Sullivan**

*Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,*

*By now you may have heard that the Diocese of Lansing, Michigan, after an investigation, found accusations of sexual abuse of minors by Bishop James Sullivan, the sixth Bishop of Fargo, to be credible. The accusations allege that these events took place several decades ago when Bishop Sullivan was a priest of the Diocese of Lansing. There have been no allegations made against Bishop Sullivan during his time as Bishop of Fargo or after his retirement. Bishop Sullivan died in 2006, and obviously cannot respond to these allegations.*

*As a result of these allegations, the Diocese of Fargo has added Bishop Sullivan's name to its list of clergy who served or ever lived in the Diocese of Fargo and who are on the list of another diocese or religious order. Sullivan Middle School in Fargo was named after Bishop Sullivan. Due to this situation, Sullivan Middle School has been renamed Sacred Heart Middle School.*

*Of course, we are all saddened at this report about Bishop Sullivan. I ask that we all join in prayer for healing and continue in our resolve and efforts to protect those who are served by the Church, especially children and young people. May God bless you and your families.*
