Gods Gift Appeal: Two Parishes Made Goal, and Two Very Near!

So far the Diocese has received from us: \$2880 from Aneta, (goal 2771), Cooperstown \$11,348 (goal 11,994), Finley \$4330 (goal 5412) and Jessie \$9791 (goal 7752) As a Quad Parish group, that brings our total giving to \$28,349 vs the total combined goals of \$27,929. So while we are just a bit short in two parishes, we have reached what the Diocese is hoping to see from us here in the Quad Parish community. Well done!
