### **Haiti Earthquake Relief Special Collection**

**See the special envelopes marked “Haiti Earthquake Relief” in the church entries, for your donation to be placed in the collection between August 29 and September 12. Make checks payable to your parish, earmark “Haiti Relief” and we will get them to the diocese from there.**

Prompted by the massive earthquake and tropical storm that hit Haiti, Archbishop Gomez, President of the USCCB, sent a letter to all bishops asking them to consider taking up a voluntary special collection to support the Church and humanitarian needs arising from this and any future disasters. Collected funds will be used where they are most needed.

The weekend of September 25-26 is Catholic Charities North Dakota Sunday which is separate and distinct from the disaster collection.

### **September 1: World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation**

**This is the subject of our “Fireside with Father Dale” message for the week on the StGeorge Cooper Youtube channel.** Our instruction for daily Mass readings and feasts notes: Today (September 1) is to be observed annually as the World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation which “will offer individual believers and communities a fitting opportunity to reaffirm their personal vocation to be stewards of creation, to thank God for the wonderful handiwork which he has entrusted to our care, and to implore his help for the protection of creation as well as his pardon for the sins committed against the world in which we live.” (Pope Francis, 6 August 2015)

The ENTHRONEMENT of the Sacred Heart means (in the words of Father Mateo) *the Official and Social recognition of the loving Kingship of the Heart of Jesus in the Christian family.* The family shows this recognition by giving the image of the Sacred Heart a place of honor in the home and dedicating itself to Him by an act of consecration. In this way the family is brought under the benign influence of the Divine Heart, which asserts itself in all the events of family life.
