In this way the family is brought under the benign influence of the Divine Heart, which asserts itself in all the events of family life.

**October Mass Counts FYI:** Based on information given by our counters, we submitted the following “**average October attendance**” to our Dean, Msgr Dennis Skonseng: **Cooperstown:** avg 85.5 of 113 parishioners (76%); **Jessie:** avg 67.0 of 80 parishioners (84%); **Finley:** 23.67 of 49 parishioners (48%); **Aneta:** 16.75 of 33 parishioners (51%). Very good overall, compared to what our larger cities experience. Visitors help “pad” the number of course. **And we realize Quad Parish members attend one another’s churches due to schedule rotation. So overall we are 176 of 275 or 64% attendance. Well done, all in all!**
