The ENTHRONEMENT of the Sacred Heart means (in the words of Father Mateo) *the Official and Social recognition of the loving Kingship of the Heart of Jesus in the Christian family.* The family shows this recognition by giving the image of the Sacred Heart a place of honor in the home and dedicating itself to Him by an act of consecration. In this way the family is brought under the benign influence of the Divine Heart, which asserts itself in all the events of family life.

October Mass Counts FYI: Based on information given by our counters, we submitted the following “**average October attendance**” to our Dean, Msgr Dennis Skonseng: **Cooperstown:** avg 85.5 of 113 parishioners (76%); **Jessie:** avg 67.0 of 80 parishioners (84%); **Finley:** 23.67 of 49 parishioners (48%); **Aneta:** 16.75 of 33 parishioners (51%). Very good overall, compared to what our larger cities experience. Visitors help “pad” the number of course. **And we realize Quad Parish members attend one another’s churches due to schedule rotation. So overall we are 176 of 275 or 64% attendance. Well done, all in all!**
