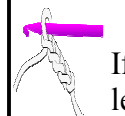

VIRTUS TRAINING

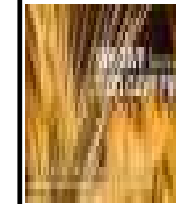

2019 SODALTY MARDI GRAS FUNDRAISER DANCE

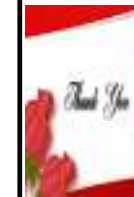

The 2019 Offertory Envelopes are now available in the back of the church. The envelopes are arranged in alphabetical order by last name — not by number.

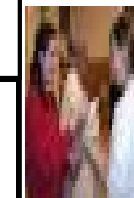
PLEASE NOTE: Envelope numbers may have been re-assigned so you may not have the same number as last year. Please look for your envelope according to your name.

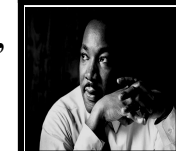
VOLUNTEERS NEEDED
