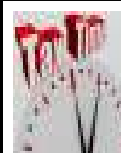
"SAINT JOSEPH'S FEAST DAY" TUESDAY, MARCH 19th

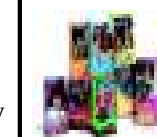

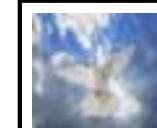
MARDI GRAS PANCAKE BREAKFAST
