GUIDANCE REGARDING CORONAVIRUS

As a reminder, no one is ever under an obligation to shake hands during the Sign of Peace (a statement of peace, fist-bump, bow or other gesture is appropriate) or to receive from the chalice. Christ is fully present in each species when the bread and wine have been consecrated into His Body and Blood. You can also choose to receive the Body of Christ in the hand instead of on the tongue. Further, anyone who is ill, or suspects he or she is ill, should refrain from receiving from the chalice out of good will, or if warranted, refrain from participation in public activities, including Mass. If you need to refrain from Sunday Mass, you are dispensed from the Sunday obligation.
