Make an Appointment for Required Immunizations at [vaccinate.dc.gov](http://vaccinate.dc.gov) Mayor Bowser is encouraging families to get back on track with required immunizations, and the District is making it easier for families to get children their required pediatric immunizations before the start of the school year. Choose to make an appointment to get their child's required immunizations at 37 sites across DC. Families will be able to schedule their children ages 3-18 years-old for their routine childhood vaccinations that are needed to go back to school. Additionally, families will have the option to add on a COVID-19 vaccine at the time of scheduling.
