**Adult Ed Classes** will resume on Weds., January 8, at 6:30 p.m. in our Church Hall. New members are always welcome.



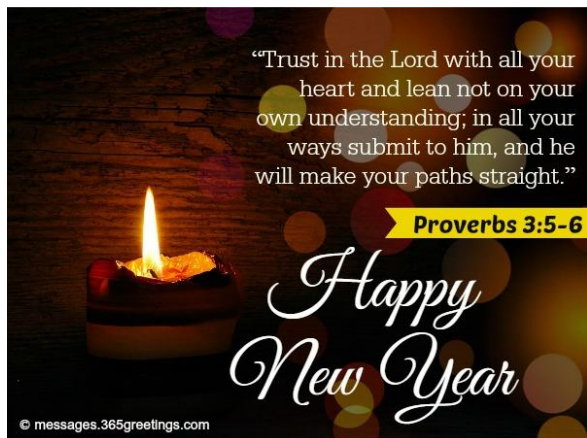
