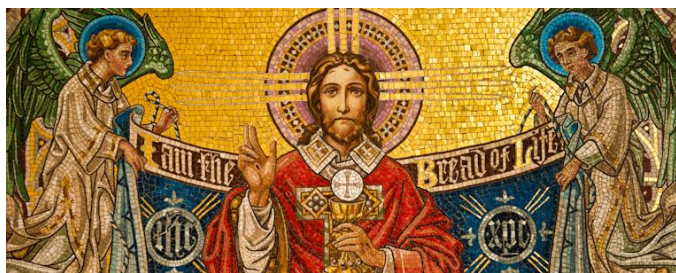

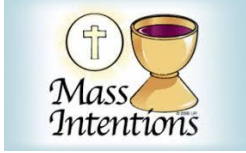

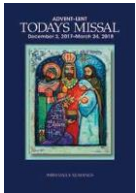
IN OUR PARISH

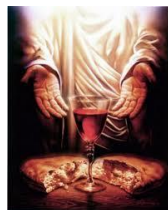
IN OUR DIOCESE
