The Epiphany, celebrated today, recalls the revelation of the Lord to the gentile world. The three visitors bring gifts of significance: gold for a king; frankincense for God; myrrh for one who will die (crucified for our sins). "Magi" is the Latin plural for "magus," meaning a "wise man" (Persian) or magician. They were depicted as kings because it was thought they were wealthy and royal to be able to travel afar on camels and to present such gifts.
