January 22, 2021 is the 48th anniversary of the Roe v. Wade Supreme Court decision legalizing abortion. The Catholic Church across the United States marks this day as a day of prayer for the legal protection of unborn children. Although the Hocking County Right to Life will not be holding a pro-life rally this year, the annual Respect Life Mass in Columbus will be celebrated by Bishop Brennan at St. Joseph Cathedral at 10:30 a.m. on Friday, Jan. 22.
