**From the Pastor's Desk:** On 12 January, Cardinal Sarah, the head of the Office of Divine Worship, sent out a statement that because of the Pandemic the distribution of Ashes should be accomplished in a different manner than is normally used in the United States. His note stated, "The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with Holy Water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general 'Repent, and believe in the Gospel' or 'Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return.' The priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask, and distributes the ashes to those who come to him, or if appropriated, he goes to those who are standing in their places. The priest takes the ashes and sprinkles them on the head of each one without saying anything." This tradition, after doing some research, is the common way of distributing ashes in most of the world. As it stands, this will be the way we will distribute the ashes this year. - Fr. Steve
