Stations of the Cross will be held on the Fridays during Lent at 6:00 p.m. in Church beginning Feb. 19. Good Friday times will be: Walking Stations - 10:00 a.m.; Church Stations - 3:00 p.m.

Lenten Rules/Regulations: On Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all Fridays of Lent, everyone age 14 and up must abstain from eating meat. On Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, everyone age 18 - 59 must fast, consuming only one full meal a day, with two smaller meals allowed unless exempt-such as for medical reasons.
