**Stations of the Cross:** Fridays during Lent in Church at 6:00 p.m. Good Friday Stations times are: 10:00 a.m. (Walking Stations) and 3:00 p.m. (in Church).

**Knights of Columbus Fundraisers:** Virtual Fish Fry: Since we are not doing fish fries in person, we are doing “virtual” fish fries this year. We have coupons for either one Fish Sandwich Combo Meal or one Shrimp Basket with Drink at Dairy Queen in Logan. The fish sandwich meal is usually \$6.79, and the shrimp basket with drink would be \$8.69. We are selling the coupons for \$6.00 each, or 2 for \$11.00, or 4 for \$20.00. Just like our real fish fries, large families can save more by buying more coupons. We are also selling coupons from Olde Dutch Restaurant for \$10.00 each, which, if you purchase their seafood platter, they will take a dollar off their regular price. Finally, we are selling “Slice the Price” cards from Dominos Pizza for \$10.00 each, which allow you to buy one or more large pizzas, and get one or more additional large pizzas free. You can use it any number of times until it expires on December 31, 2021. So, if you don’t like fish, fill up on cheese or veggie pizzas on Fridays during Lent and use it all year long after that. We will have these available after Masses, on a table in the church vestibule, and in the Church Hall, or you can buy them individually from a Knight who has some. What we earn from these will go entirely to our charitable causes, including to the parish for needed repairs in the church or otherwise. Thank you.
