New Appointment for Bishop Brennan:

On September 29, 2021, the Vatican announced that Pope Francis has appointed the Most Reverend Robert J. Brennan, Bishop of Columbus, as the Eighth Bishop of the Diocese of Brooklyn, New York. A Mass of Installation for Bishop Brennan will be celebrated on Tuesday, November 30, 2021 at 2:00 p.m. at the Co-Cathedral of St. Joseph. "I have been very happy here in Ohio and am heartbroken that I will be leaving," Bishop Brennan said. "I came to know amazing people here, and there is tremendous sadness leaving you behind." He also commented, "To the people of the Diocese of Columbus, I recognize this announcement comes as an enormous surprise, but we entrust ourselves to the Lord, and we will move forward confident that the Holy Spirit is the constant guide for the Church and its people, especially when a new bishop will be chosen to lead the Diocese of Columbus. All of you are in my prayers in a very special way today, and you will remain in my prayers and my heart every day of my life. Please pray for me as well. Continue placing your trust in our loving Lord and carry on this marvelous journey of faith that we have been on together these last two and a half years as fellow missionary disciples of our Lord and savior." The Vatican will announce a successor to Bishop Brennan at a future date. In the meantime, he will lead the Diocese of Columbus until November 30th. Then the diocesan College of Consultors will elect a diocesan administrator to lead until a new bishop is appointed and installed.
