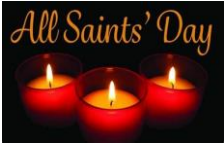

IN OUR DIOCESE

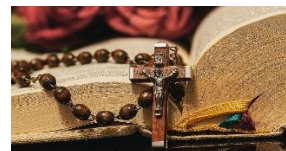
