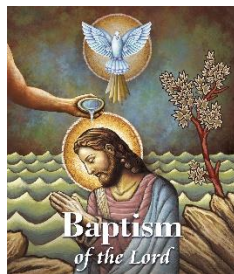

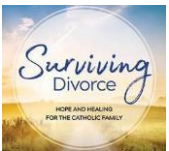
New Church Cleaning Schedules are available in the vestibule of church. Please pick up a copy if you are on the list. Thank you!
