We realize that this is going to be a great sacrifice for many, but our goal is to keep our school open for in-person learning - something students pray for daily. Please follow the below recommendations when planning for any type of travel or gathering.

Type of Travel	Recommended Precautions
Any domestic or international travel	Travelers should be vigilant about following recommended precautions to prevent exposure to others. <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Practice social distancing (maintain a distance of 6 feet)● Wear a cloth face covering● Wash hands regularly● Be alert for symptoms<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Watch for fever, cough, shortness of breath, and other symptoms of COVID-19● Follow CDC guidance if symptoms develop
Situations with potentially higher risk of exposure, such as: <ul style="list-style-type: none">● Travel from another country, a U.S. state, or a county (according to state data) where COVID-19 transmission is high or increasing● Attendance at large social or mass gatherings● Travel on a cruise ship or river boat	Travelers should take the following precautions in addition to the ones listed above. <ul style="list-style-type: none">● For 14 days after travel:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Stay home or in a comparable location (such as a hotel room) to the extent possible○ Avoid contact with people at higher risk for severe illness● Consider getting tested for COVID-19
