

Guidelines for Daily Mass at St. Joseph's

Mass will be offered daily at St. Joseph's Church at Noon, Monday through Friday

- There will be no Mass at the nursing homes or St. Joseph's School until further notice
- There will be no public Mass at St. Alexius Hospital Chapel.

Use Mother Theresa Hall doors only

If you are sick, not feeling well, coughing or sneezing; please stay home

- If you are elderly, or are vulnerable to illness; consider staying home
- If you do not feel safe at a public Mass at this time in the pandemic, consider staying home

The School Mass will still be Facebook livestreamed at Noon on May 8, 15, and 18.

Seating is limited to every other pew and on the Mother Theresa Hall side only

- Each person will seat themselves
- Please keep 6 feet between you and anyone not in your household

Personal hygiene and sanitization

- We cannot kill every germ in our church/adoration chapel
- There is no substitute for your own personal hygiene and sanitization practices
- Please wash/sanitize your hands upon arriving and leaving
- Avoid touching your face
- If you have a mask, please bring it and wear it correctly (covering nose to chin)

Bathrooms

- Sanitize toilet handle, toilet seat, sink handles, and door handle
- PLEASE WASH YOUR HANDS!!!
- After washing your hands use paper towel to shut off water and open door
- Do not discard anything in the toilet other than toilet paper

Please do not linger or socialize in Church or Mother Theresa Hall and maintain 6 feet social distancing

Holy Communion

- Please allow person/household in front of you 6 feet space
- Please remove or lower your mask in line
- Hand sanitizer will be provided
- Please receive Holy Communion in the hand
- Be conscious of 6 feet rule as you return to your pew

Those who are gluten intolerant may receive Communion in the Precious Blood; please notify the priest if you are attending Mass
