## OUR PREVENTION PROGRAM

Door of Hope's prevention program aims to help families *before* they become homeless by:

- Addressing their immediate financial crisis
- Preventing eviction
- Providing case management services

## COVID-19: CRISIS CREATES AN INCREASED NEED

- Unemployment is at 19.4% in LA county, as of June 2020
- Because of COVID-19 related loss, more families are at risk of homelessness, and many for the first time

## OUR PROGRAM SERVES FAMILIES WHO

- Have at least 1 child 18 or younger
- Reside in LA County
- Have verification of unpaid rent
- Have experienced significant loss due to COVID-19
- The household's total annual gross income must be 50% or less of the AMI.

## HOW WE HELP

Our program supports families with:

- 3 months of \$1000 each towards rent and/or utilities
- 2 sessions of case management each month, 6 in total, equipping families with skills and resources like budgeting, job training and paraprofessional counseling
