You may also include a photo if the article would benefit with a visual. Some ideas to write about:

- Share a story about when you experienced God's love or mercy
- What is your testimony? Your conversion story? Your re-conversion story? What keeps you Catholic?
- What miracle, big or small, have you witnessed? How did it affect you?
- What is your vocation story?
- What Church teaching have you struggled with and how did God lead you through it?
- What is your favorite scripture or prayer? What about it speaks to you?
- Who encouraged or continues to encourage you on your faith journey? In what way?
