

Playground Gates:

Just a reminder -- our students will be utilizing the playground and the campus grounds more than they have in the past this year. The campus grounds will be used for mask breaks, outdoor classrooms, and scheduled recess. EdChoice - 2021-2022 School Year

An email was sent out via OptionC on February 10 with detailed information about the EdChoice Expansion Scholarship which is based on income. We now have more information about the EdChoice Traditional Scholarship now that the window opened on March 2, 2021.

<u>EdChoice Traditional Scholarship Program</u> – The following is a list of public schools that are designated for the EdChoice Traditional Scholarship. Schools are designated if they are:

- 1. Ranked in the lowest 20% in the Performance Index Rankings for both the 2017-2018 & 2018-2019 school years; and
- 2. Operated by a school district for which the average Title 1 formula percentage is 20% or above across the last three school years (2018-2019, 2019-2020, and 2020-2021 school years).

School buildings are also designated if they are operated by a school district that has an Academic Distress Commission in place.

You can click **HERE** to see the list of schools that are on the list for the 2021-22 school year.

To apply for the Traditional Scholarship, students must be new to a private/parochial school for the 2021-22 school year (which includes kindergarteners). Students must be enrolled in or attending an EdChoice public school building or be assigned to an EdChoice building for the upcoming school year.

For a list of facts about how eligibility is determined, you can click <u>HERE</u> to get that information. Feel free to contact the school office if you still have questions. We will be happy to help.

Feel free to pass this information on to your friends if their public school appears on the list and they are currently enrolled in a public school. We are still enrolling for the 2021-21 school year.

<u>EdChoice Expansion Scholarship Program</u> - this is a state sponsored program based on your family's income. The window for applying for this scholarship opened on Feb. 1st.

If your family is currently on an EdChoice Expansion Scholarship for the 2020-21 school year, you need to complete the 2021-22 EdChoice Renewal Form and submit the form with any documents to the school office. This information and documents were emailed via OptionC to families currently receiving the Expansion Scholarship on Feb. 5th.

If you have any questions about your child's eligibility for any of the EdChoice scholarships, please contact the school office.

Library Online Book Catalog

Students can now access our school library on-line catalog from our web page. This allows our students to find books they're interested in and allows parents to assist younger students in searching for books on their level and their interest. Students can check to see if the book is an AR book, along with the level and points.

At this time, students cannot put books on hold from this site but book request forms will continue to be hard copy and kept in the classrooms.

Keep in mind:

- **ER is for easy reader: Pictures book and emerging Readers. This will mostly be the books for kindergarten, 1st and 2nd grade.
- **JR Lower grade chapter books. Usually about 1-2 points for AR tests. Grades 2-4.
- **MG Harder, more challenging chapter books. Grades 2 and up.
- **Gra- Graphic Novels
- **UG Grades 6-8 only.
