## ***Gospel***

***Luke 9:51-62***

When the days for Jesus' being taken up were fulfilled, he resolutely determined to journey to Jerusalem, and he sent messengers ahead of him. On the way they entered a Samaritan village to prepare for his reception there, but they would not welcome him because the destination of his journey was Jerusalem. When the disciples James and John saw this they asked, "Lord, do you want us to call down fire from heaven to consume them?" Jesus turned and rebuked them, and they journeyed to another village.

As they were proceeding on their journey someone said to him, "I will follow you wherever you go." Jesus answered him, "Foxes have dens and birds of the sky have nests, but the Son of Man has nowhere to rest his head."

And to another he said, "Follow me." But he replied, "Lord, let me go first and bury my father." But he answered him, "Let the dead bury their dead. But you, go and proclaim the kingdom of God." And another said, "I will follow you, Lord, but first let me say farewell to my family at home." ### ***Great Changes are coming to your Parish Church!***

Over the next few weeks you will see some wonderful changes begin to occur in your Church.

- You will see the ventilators at the bottom of the stained-glass windows disappear! They are being removed and repaired so they will open and close like they should. They will be re-installed in late August.
- Many of you have noticed that the plaster on the wall behind the choir loft has been deteriorating because of extensive water damage. In mid-July a project of repairing the mortar between the bricks on the front of the Church will begin. Over the years since the Church was built, in 1926, that mortar has deteriorated and is allowing rain water to come through the wall. This project will require material and equipment to be positioned at the front of the building. Please be careful in that area while this project is underway.
- Another wonderful project that will begin within the next few weeks is the restoration of the beautiful Stations of the Cross. This project will take many months to complete. The pictures will be removed a few at a time. They will be cleaned, restored, and reinstalled.

Your understanding, patience and consideration of these projects is appreciated. More information will be coming as the projects occur.


