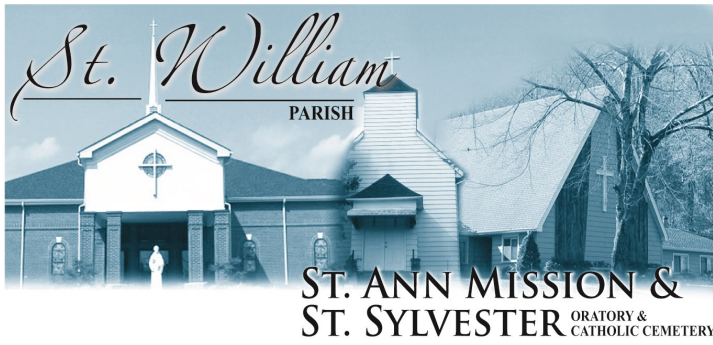

THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Pope Francis has declared this Sunday to be a "Sunday of the Word of God". Jesus Christ, to fulfill his ministry after his baptism, he called his first disciples. They were fishermen, who then would become preachers of God's word. He calls the fishermen because of these reasons:

1. A fisherman has patience. He learns to wait patiently until the fish will take the bite.
2. A fisherman has perseverance. He learns not to be discouraged but always to try again.
3. A fisherman has courage. He is ready to risk, to face the fury of the sea.
4. A fisherman has an eye for the right moment. He knows when to cast and when not to cast.
5. A fisherman must keep himself out of site.

This Sunday, let us bring to our minds our preachers, our lectors, those who proclaim the word of God every Sunday, and our catechists. **Father Vitner**
