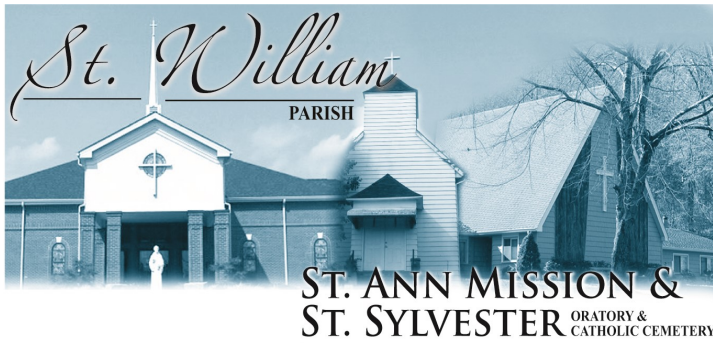

Feast of the Presentation of the Lord

Jesus is presented by his mother and father to both: Jews and Gentiles. The old Simeon has been getting ready all his life for this special event and be finally at peace. He *sees* and recognizes Jesus’ identity by saying: *my eyes have seen your salvation, a light for revelation to the Gentiles and glory for your people of Israel.* He accepts that the Child is a manifestation of God’s glory. Anna, a woman who *never left the temple, but worshiped night and day with fasting and prayer,* confirms and gives *thanks* to God and *proclaims* to all that the redemption of Jerusalem has come. St Paul in a letter to the Hebrews tells us that Jesus is our savior and has power over the devil and death because **He is the Light.**

Prayers and **fasting** will help us (1) to recognize Jesus Christ as our savior in the Eucharist, in our neighbors (family, friends, homeless, immigrants and poor). (2) The **image of Joseph and Mary presenting Jesus,** we have a wonderful model of husband and wife united together in practicing the faith and raising their child in their faith.
