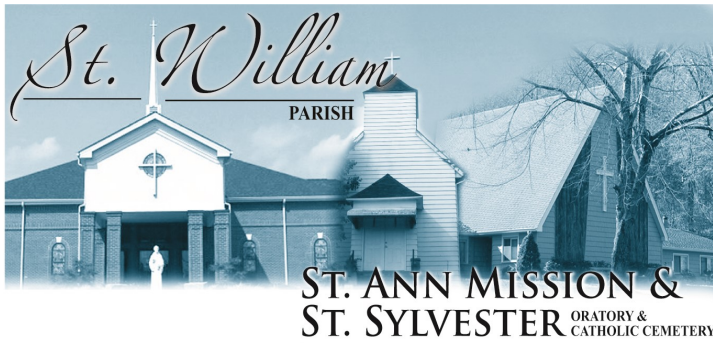

FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
