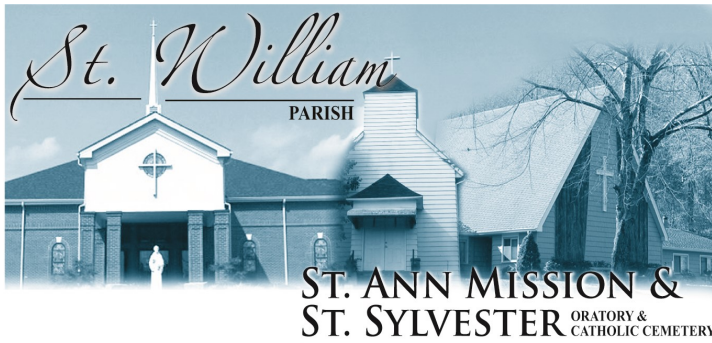

**THIRD SUNDAY OF LENT**

**Conversion: How it Works**

Conversion is always thirsting. A thirst could be physical or spiritual.

*First*, this story enhances the humanity of Jesus. The Samaritan goes deep to acknowledge who she really is.

*Second*, it shows us the warmth of his sympathy. The sympathy of Jesus calls sinners from the heat and dust of their own journeys to sit by the well and see the truth of our own existence.

*Third*, it shows Jesus as the demolisher of barriers. The quarrel between the Jews and the Samaritans was ancient.

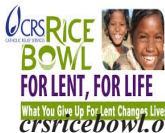
**LOOKING AHEAD: SIMPLE SOUP SUPPER**
