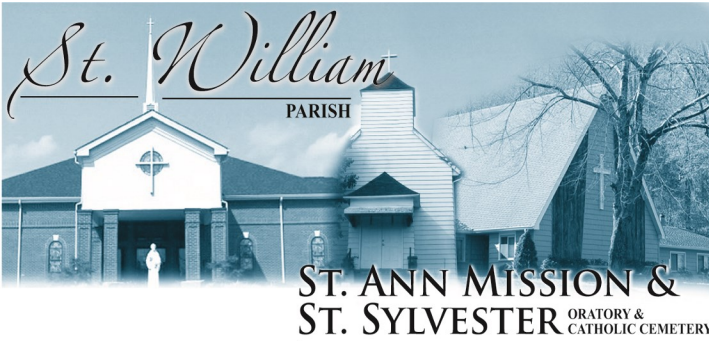

**Power of faith and salvation for all**

Mark puts two stories within today's gospel.

First we see that Jairus approaches and asks Jesus to heal his sick daughter of 12 years old. While Jesus is going to see the girl, a woman suffering from a hemorrhage for 12 years also approaches him.

The first is a prominent man of the town. The second is a woman. He has a name and she doesn't have a name. Jairus is described as "one of the synagogue officials." He is well known. We do not know the woman's occupation. He is "holy and pure"; she has "hemorrhage": un-pure, sinner and outcast. Even so, Jesus treats them both with the same respect.

Mark uncovers the similarities and differences of faith in both of them. Jairus' faith differs from that of a woman. Jairus asks Jesus to go into the house, the woman wishes to touch him and that is enough. Jairo's faith gets stronger when he sees the miracle of healing of the woman.

Salvation is for all: prominent and unknown, holy and sinner, young and old, what matters is faith in Christ.

All this time as Pastor of St William and St Ann my faith in Christ got stronger, because you: my brother and sister, showed me Christ. Let's us not loose our sight from Christ. Only to God be the Honor and Glory!

United by one faith.
