



THE CAMPAIGN

Founded in 1641 by Father Andrew White, S.J., St. Ignatius is the oldest, continuously active Catholic parish in the United States. St. Thomas Manor was built in 1741 abutting the original brick chapel that was constructed around 1697. In 1798, the church was built, using the original brick chapel as a sanctuary and a sacristy. Situated on a hill overlooking the Port Tobacco and Potomac Rivers, it is one of the most beautiful locations in all of Southern Maryland.

RESTORE & RENEW

Over the years, our beloved, historic church and manor house have aged and are in need of significant restoration and preservation. Through the hard work of our Capital Campaign Committee, we are gearing up for a three-year fundraising effort in support of St. Ignatius Chapel Point's capital project. Our Restore & Renew Capital Campaign will kick off in the fall of 2019 for the restoration and preservation of these irreplaceable icons of Maryland history and religious liberty.

PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

- > Reinforce previously repaired floor joists in center aisle of church
- > Strengthen roof framing and attic floor repairs
- > Bell tower/steeple framing and column supports
- > Pointing up and restoration of masonry
- > Restoration of balcony
- > Restoration of exterior decorative wood
- > Restoration and preservation of historic stained glass windows
- > Modernize interior lighting, electric and HVAC systems
