Each day, we wake up and make a daily decision to grow in our faith. Our parish will offer opportunities for parishioners in every age & stage to grow in faith. We will have opportunities that follow safety protocols for distancing to allow for in-person faith formation, and we will also offer virtual opportunities utilizing Google classroom and Zoom to allow everyone to have opportunities for experiencing enriching encounters with God as a member of our parish community.

We will still have our CCD program, and we will offer in-person, as allowed, and virtual religious education. Our program will look a little differently this year. This pandemic has brought us many opportunities to come together as family. “The family, so to speak, is the domestic church.” (Lumen Gentium #11) Practicing our faith in family is the surest way for us to live out God’s love. Our program will allow families to learn together, studying the same topics of faith at the same time to better help deepen the roots of faith in our everyday lives as a family together. We will use the curriculum standards for the Archdiocese of Washington, and will differentiate activities on the same topic so that all members of the family can learn where they are at on their faith journey. Our ultimate goal is that parents, grandparents, and guardians can understand their faith, and be empowered to be the best and primary educator for our children. # Health Protocols

In order to provide a safe environment for our parishioners, we will be following health protocols provided to us with the Archdiocese and in accordance with directives of our local Health Department.

- ✓ Both the Church and the Parish Hall shall be set up for activities to ensure a distance of six feet between parishioners from different families.
- ✓ Masks are to be worn in the Church and the Parish Hall for all those ages two years and above.
- ✓ Hand sanitizer is provided at the entrance, and to be used upon entry.
- ✓ Water fountains and common drinking and eating station use is suspended.
- ✓ Children shall receive their own folders and pencil bags with necessary supplies to complete activities to avoid sharing of supplies.
- ✓ Facilities shall be cleaned and disinfected immediately following use to ensure safe facilities for the next scheduled activity.

We're all in this together to keep each other healthy! Parishioners are asked to *please stay home* if **anyone in the family** is showing signs of illness to include:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Sore Throat
- Shortness of breath, difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea

WHAT TO EXPECT ON SUNDAYS:

Please encourage your children to **use the bathroom at home prior to coming** to reduce close interaction with others. Restrooms are closed and only available on an emergency basis.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand and agree that I will have my children use the bathroom prior to coming, and that bathrooms are closed and only available on an emergency basis.

All participants who attend in-person faith formation are expected to **wear masks**.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand and agree to provide masks for my child(ren) and agree that masks will be worn for the duration of faith formation activities until further directives from the Archdiocese have been issued.

In order to reduce sharing of supplies, children need to bring their provided supplies with them to class.

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand and agree to ensure my child(ren) has all supplies necessary for class and shall bring them each class.

**Participants will be welcomed and briefly assessed for signs above upon entry.**

Catechists are to notify Director of Religious Education immediately if they, or any of their students are exhibiting any of these signs to allow for a consultation to assess signs.

**If any youth or staff exhibit signs above, they are to be isolated until they can be picked up immediately. Emergency contact information must be provided prior to participating in faith formation activities.**

\_\_\_\_\_ I understand and agree that I, or my emergency contact(s), can be available to pick up my child(ren) if staff assesses signs of illness are exhibited, and that my child(ren) may be isolated for the safety and health of all participants.

By signing this form, I acknowledge the health protocols put in place to ensure in-person faith formation may occur, and I agree to have my family follow these protocols.
