Free Drive Thru Flu Shot Clinics

Brown County Health & Human Services is sponsoring 2 **free** drive thru flu shot clinics.

They are for individuals age 6 months and older. Their requirements are:

- ✓ Must wear a mask.
- ✓ Wear clothing that is easily accessible to the shoulder. Example: short sleeve shirt under coat.
- ✓ For very young children, wear clothing that is easily accessible to the thigh. (Ask yourself – how are vaccines administered when you take your child to the pediatrician.)

Box Tops App

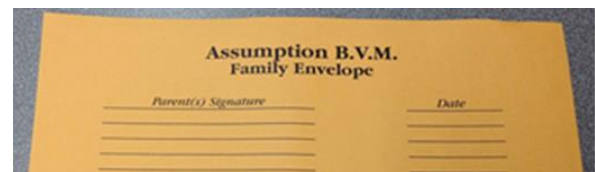
Last year, the Box Tops program switched to a digital App. To earn \$.10 per Box Top now, you **scan store receipts** instead of cutting out Box Tops. Some people have already added the app to their phone or other device. Thank you!

We need **your** help to continue with our past success of this program.

- Prior to the new method, we earned an average of **\$1,513.00 per year**.
- This year, we have earned **\$46.00** to date.
- In previous years, we have earned **at least \$225.00** by this time in the school year.

The scanning method is very simple. There are directions on the website. Go to the Resources tab, Support Programs and scroll down to Box Tops Program. Please encourage family and friends to participate as well. For people who are not “App Savvy”, they can turn in receipts.
