Boxes and individual candy bars are available **in the office**.

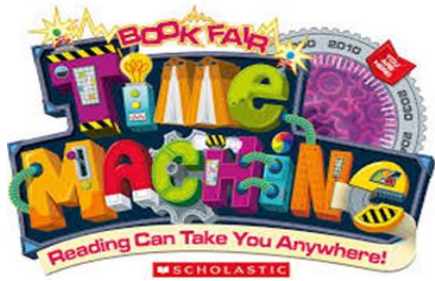
For the **individual** candy bars, we are out of **Almond & Shock Rock**.

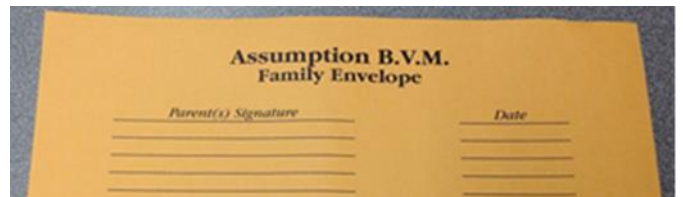
Bus Transportation
