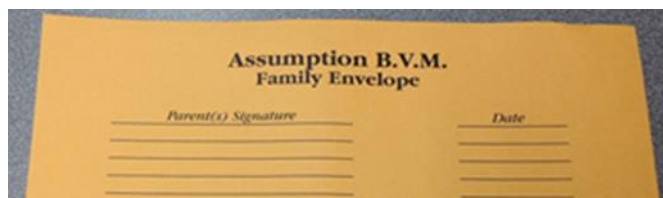
## Candy Bar Procedures
