### **Kala LTP-SCC Learn to Play Color Chord Soprano**

**Ukulele** PURCHASING THESE IS NOT REQUIRED. *Some students purchased these ukuleles as Christmas presents this past December. It's only \$40 and has colors on the frets so students can play 4 chords easily by placing their fingers on the color chord positions. It's also found on Amazon. If you purchase any other, make sure there are gears on the tuning pegs or they will not stay in tune.*

This website shows you how to **tune a ukulele** without a tuner and play a one chord song. Remember anytime you turn the tuning PEG be sure to be strumming the string you are tuning. Turning the string too much will cause the string to break. The second site is for tuners. Everyone try the first link here to **play one chord songs**.
