Before, After, & Wrap

Around Care Statements

If your family uses **Before or After** Care, you will receive a weekly statement in your family envelope. If you use **Wrap Around** Care (for 3-Year-Old Preschool & 4K students), you will also receive a weekly statement.

The statement will include the amount owed for each day, as well as any payments received through Monday of that week’s statement.

You can pay weekly or monthly, whatever works best for your budget. If you choose the monthly option, we ask that you please **pre-pay**.



Health Update

- Please be sure to monitor your children every day before school by: temperature checking and asking if they have: a sore throat, stuffy/runny nose, headache, shortness of breath.
- If your student has any of these symptoms, please call the office. By explaining the symptoms and/or combination of symptoms, we will let you know if your child is OK to come to school, should stay home or contact your health care provider. We understand this is a major inconvenience. Our primary goal is to keep our students and staff healthy and keep school open.
- Thank you for all the calls to the office with questions and explaining symptoms. We understand what an inconvenience it is to keep your students home with minor symptoms; however, we have **0 cases** of COVID reported to us! That keeps Assumption open and available to teach face to face. Thanks again!!!!

Blessing of Pets Ceremony

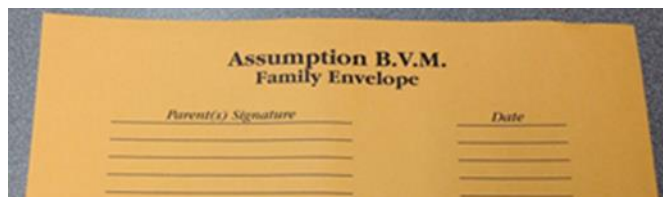
