### Third Source Funding

A copy of your family's Third Source Funding (TSF) statement is in this week's family envelope. There are **two ways to satisfy** the \$150 per student requirement for **grades 4K-5**.

1. Purchase \$CRIP and 50% of your credit is applied.
2. Pay the amount (or any remaining amount, if some \$CRIP was purchased) with cash or check.

\$CRIP can be purchased through **April 30, 2022** and be applied to this year's Third Source Funding.

For your convenience, we have included a \$CRIP order form that you may complete and send to school with your student. The office will have the \$CRIP order filled and return to your student to bring home that same night. If you prefer, you can pick up your order in the office after school.
