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Service Hour Opportunities

3. **Almsgiving** ~ Giving to those who do not have as much as you. During Lent, your family can collect money in a rice bowl.

Note: Every family is receiving a rice bowl with a Lenten calendar tucked inside.

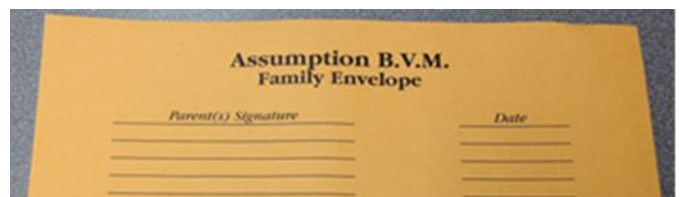


Reminder ~ Bus Students
