Service Hour Opportunities

Playground/Lunchroom Volunteer ~ Wednesdays, 11:20-12:20: Supervise students during lunch and recess. Same requirements as Afterschool Care Volunteer. Hours of service would equal number of hours volunteered.

Note: Great opportunity for 4K parents ~ your 4K ABVM student can stay through the end of recess with a free lunch.

Read-a-thon Coordinator (similar to the Walk-a-thon): Organize, prepare and follow up with a Read-a-Thon fundraiser. Would be able to utilize other volunteers for some of the components. Hours of service to be determined.

Afterschool Care Volunteer: Supervise students during aftercare. Must have Protecting God's Children training, register as a volunteer with the Diocese of Green Bay, and complete a background check. Hours of service would equal number of hours volunteered.

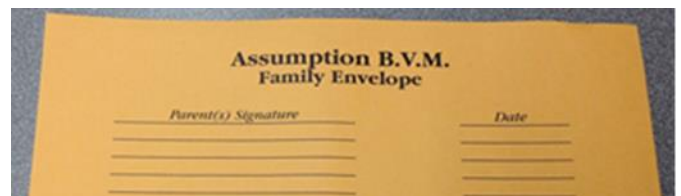
