Saturday, March 20, 2021

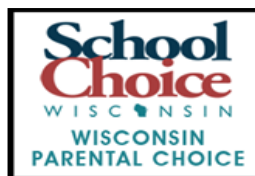
9:00-11:00 am

This event is open to all families with children ages 3 or 4 years old, respectively, by September 1, 2021 and are planning for the 2021-2022 school year.

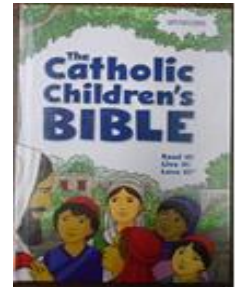
Families can register for a 15 minute time slot to meet the teacher, see the classroom, and have some play time. Tours of the school will be available after their visit with the teacher.

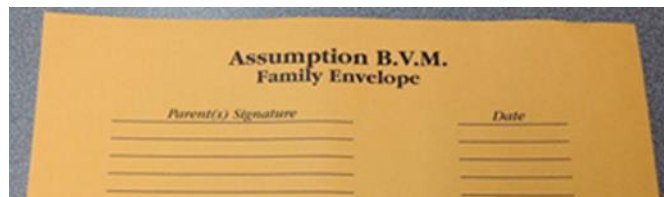


Stations of the Cross
