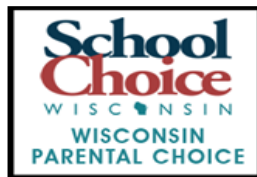

9:00-11:00 am

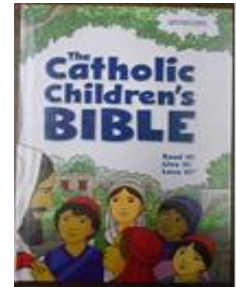
Interested families can register for a 15 minute time slot to meet the teacher, see the classroom, and have some play time. Tours of the school will be available.

- 3. Almsgiving** ~ Giving as an act of charity.

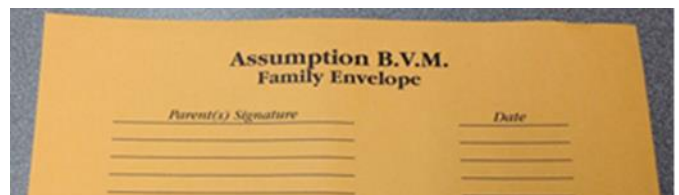
