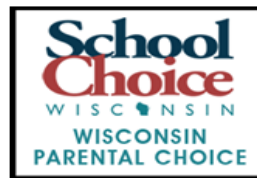

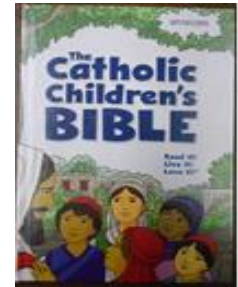
Assumption BVM School participates in the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program (WPCP). Families who meet the eligibility requirements can have their students attend **tuition-free**.

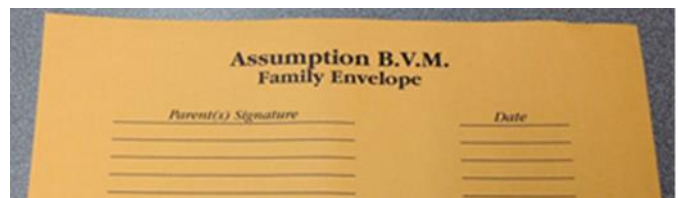
