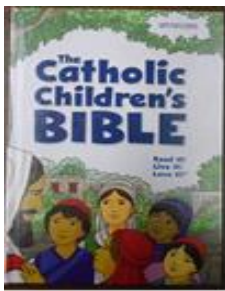

Coffee & Candy Bars

We have extended **coffee orders** through this **Friday, April 23rd**.

Candy Bar Procedures

- Boxes are \$72.00 each.
- **Pre-mixed variety** boxes have 48 *assorted flavor* candy bars. Flavors are: Chocolate, Mint, Peanut Butter, Almond, Crisp, Dark Chocolate, Shock Rock, and Mocha.
- If you prefer, you can do a **special order** box, and the total number of candy bars will still be 48.
- Sell the candy bars for \$1.50 each. You can also eat them, use as gifts, etc. Families keep the money from the sales.
- NOTE:** Unsold candy bars cannot be returned.
- As soon as we reach **30** boxes ordered, we will also begin individual candy bar sales. They are \$1.50 each.
- Half of the proceeds from sales go to Assumption BVM School.

Third Source Funding

There are **2 ways to satisfy** the \$150 per student requirement for grades 4K-5.

1. Purchase \$CRIP and 50% of your credit is applied through **April 30, 2021** for the 2020-2021 TSF amount.
2. Pay the amount (or any remaining amount, if some \$CRIP was purchased) with cash or check.

Service Hour Opportunities

NEW ~ Plant Sale: This annual sale is held in May. Help is needed with potting plants, set up before the sale, being available during the sale, and take down after. Hours of service would equal the number of hours volunteered.

NEW ~ Running Club: Ms. Kabat will lead during the month of May on Mon. & Wed. (see note below)
Parents would stretch with and help run with the students. Must have Protecting God's Children training, register as a volunteer with the Diocese of Green Bay, and complete a background check. Hours of service would equal number of sessions attended.

NEW ~ Updating documents and forms for the office: Documents to be typed using Microsoft Office Word. If you are interested but do not have Word or do not have a computer, please contact the office. Hours of service would equal number of hours volunteered.

Afterschool Care Volunteer: Supervise students during aftercare. Must have Protecting God's Children training, register as a volunteer with the Diocese of Green Bay, and complete a background check. Hours of service would equal number of hours volunteered.

Playground/Lunchroom Volunteer ~ Wednesdays, 11:20-12:20: Supervise students during lunch and recess. Same requirements as Afterschool Care Volunteer. Hours of service would equal number of hours volunteered.
Note: Great opportunity for 4K parents ~ your 4K ABVM student can stay through the end of recess with a free lunch.

NOTE: Service Hours may be accumulated through the end of the school year.

Running Club Mon. & Wed. during May

Students in **grades 3-5** can participate. Meet in the gym after school. Stretch in the gym first, then run. End time will vary. All participants will receive a calendar with specific times. Please sign up by the end of the day next week **Wednesday, April 28**.

If a student who is younger than third grade is interested, he/she can participate **only if** a parent runs with the student for every session.

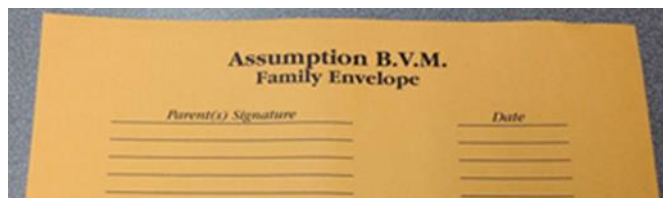
