Police Chief Mark Hendzel is looking for a morning Crossing Guard for the corner of Pulaski and St. Augustine Streets. (Our school intersection)

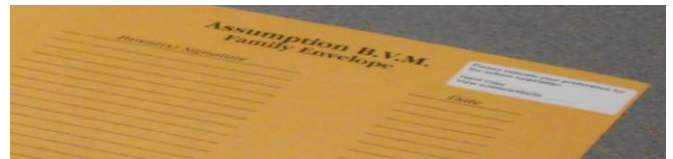
- The time commitment would be about 7:10-7:45 am for every day school is in session.
