Please read the document you received last week to see how you can help with events while earning Service Hours.

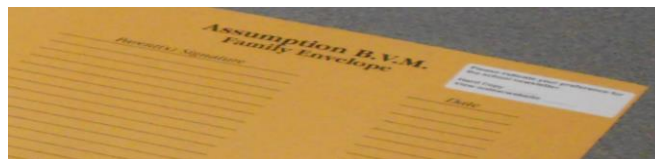
- **After Care supervisor** ~ even if you would consider *one of the days* (Monday, Wednesday, or Friday), it would be greatly appreciated.
