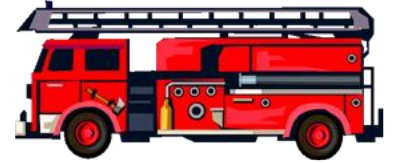

Playground/Lunchroom Supervisor ~ We have an opening on Thursdays. We can also use a couple more substitutes on an as needed basis.



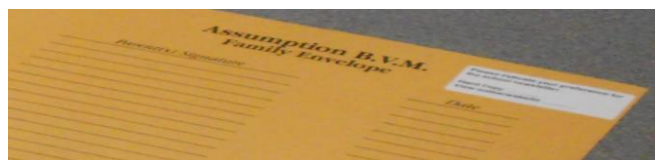
Girls & Boys Basketball
